

FRIENDS OF SCOUTING (FOS) 2012 UNIT REWARDS PROGRAM

The Unit Rewards Program is designed to encourage 100 percent unit participation in the FOS program, and to promote 100 percent participation (or average minimum donation per scout) by every family within the unit.

How to become eligible for the Rewards Program:

- ✓ Assign an FOS Unit Coordinator/Pledge Patrol Leader
- ✓ Attend the FOS Kick-Off Breakfast
- ✓ Host an FOS presentation, conduct a Letter Writing Campaign, or hold some other form of fundraiser to support the 2012 FOS Campaign.
- ✓ *Achieve FOS goal by May 31, 2012.*

Note: Matching and VIP gifts from employers will count towards your unit goal.

2012 Rewards Selection

Units that achieve their goals and meet the above criteria can choose one of the following:

Forestburg

- **1 Free Tent Camp Site for a Weekend (Fri.-Sun.)***
- **\$40 off the cost of any building rental***

Quail Hill

- **2 Hours on the BB Range ****
- **2 Hours on the Archery Range****
- **2 Hours of Pool Rental*****
- **1 Free Camp Site for a Weekend (Fri. - Sun.)***
- **\$40 off the cost of building rental***

*No "head fees" will be required. Fees for heating, fire wood, grills, other facilities or equipment will be charged to the unit if applicable.

**Unit must provide their own BSA trained BB & Archery masters. A deposit check for equipment will still be required but will be returned if all equipment is returned without damage.

***The unit is responsible for providing; scheduling and paying certified Life Guard(s), and Safe Swim Defense Trained adults (as outlined in the Guide to Safe Scouting). Names of potential life guards can be obtained from the Service Center.

Rewards Note: All rewards are based on availability and must be redeemed by Dec. 31, 2012. All reservations for use of the rewards must be made through the Council Camping Office and be scheduled at least 6 weeks prior to the event. Council reserves the change the reservation if necessary due to weather or other circumstances.
