



## Mandatory Updated Adult Youth Protection Training

### Quick Facts

In some states this may be known as the mandatory reporter of child abuse training required by state law.

#### **BSA National Mandatory Training Policy**

- Youth Protection Training (YPT) must be taken every two years.
- **Councils are permitted to enact additional requirements.**

#### **Monmouth Council's Policy**

**Every adult leader in the Monmouth Council is required to have a Youth Protection Training Certificate that is valid for the entire period of the charter.** In other words, every adult in Monmouth Council is required to undergo Youth Protection Training **more frequently than every two years** in order to always have a valid training certificate. This supersedes the expiration date on the certificate.

#### **Mandatory Training**

The Boy Scouts of America's updated Youth Protection Training is **mandatory** for **all** registered adult leaders in **all** BSA programs. Other adults participating in Scouting are strongly encouraged to take this one-hour online training.

The mandatory training modules are the following:

- Overview and Policies
- Sexual Abuse
- Bullying

The prior version of BSA's Youth Protection trainings will no longer be available. The updated training replaces other Youth Protection trainings and is required for all BSA programs.

#### **Recommended Training**

Additional modules on related topics will be released at a later date and are recommended for all leaders. The topics will include:

- Neglect
- Physical Abuse
- Exposure to Violence
- Emotional Abuse

**By October 1, 2018, all new and currently registered leaders will be required to complete the updated training.** The enhanced and updated content will allow leaders and councils to comply with all current

legal requirements. While this may be inconvenient for some, it reflects the BSA's commitment to the safety of all youth.

- Adults accompanying units on activities who are present at the activity for 72 hours or more, must also take Youth Protection Training. The **72 hours need not be consecutive.**
- **New leaders** are required to take Youth Protection Training prior to completing the registration process.
- Units cannot **re-charter** unless all unit leaders have ~~completed YPT within two years~~ a YPT certificate that is valid throughout the term of the charter.
- Adult Youth Protection Training is required for adult program participants 18 years or older. Adult program participants (Venturing, Order of the Arrow, Exploring) must complete adult Youth Protection Training before submitting their adult application.

The **only position exceptions** to taking the required the Youth Protection Training are:

- institutional heads and
- adult partners in Tiger and Lion programs.

Other quick facts:

- Parents and guardians are **strongly encouraged** to take the training.
- The training is **closed captioned.**
- **Spanish** version will be available mid-2018.

### **Face-to-face Training**

Face-to-face training is now available at the council service center for those leaders who are unable to complete it online. Full information is available at <https://www.monmouthbsa.org/ypt>. Training dates will be posted on the council calendar.

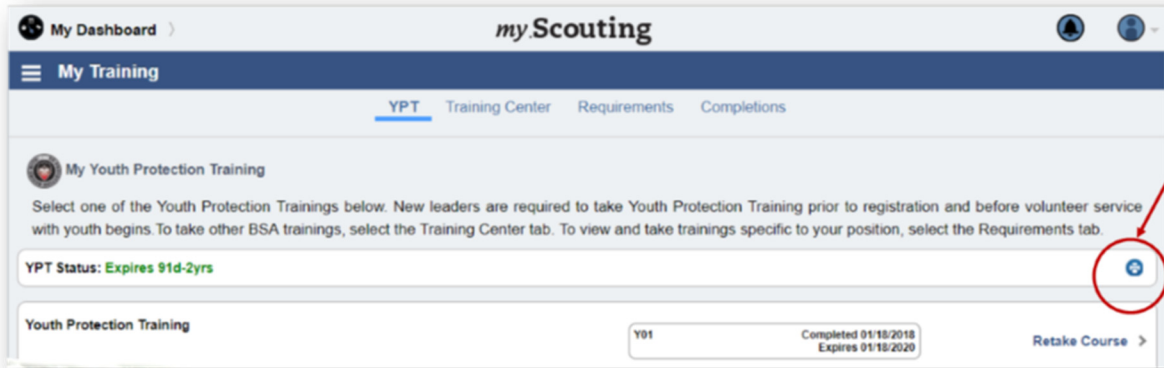
### **my.Scouting Account Users**

You must have a my.Scouting.org account to take the training, but BSA registration is not required. BSA chartering organizations are welcome to take the training free of charge.

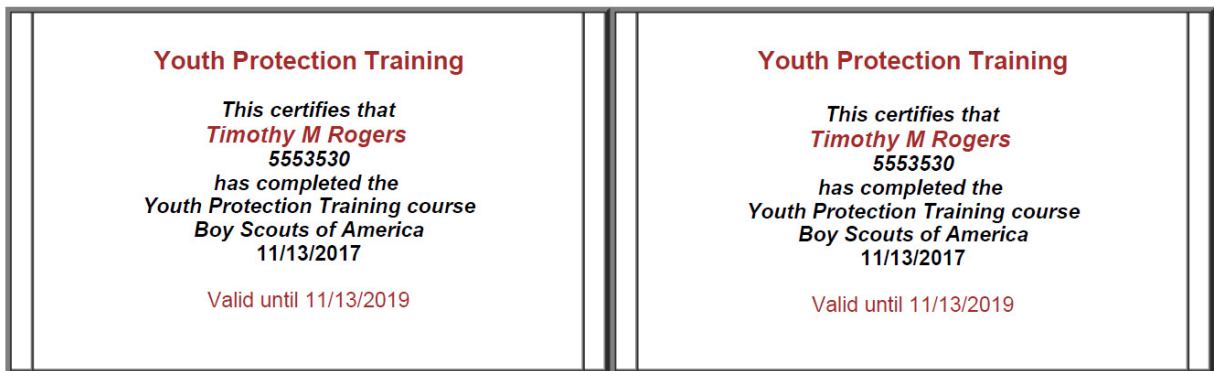
### **Printing Training Completion Certificate**

Effective now, when completing the 4 modules of the Youth Protection Training course on the BSA Learn Center, the system will automatically email a PDF attachment of the Youth Protection Certificate to the email associated to your myscouting account! This YPT certificate will include the completion date and the expiration date. No more guessing when your YPT will expire, and no more waiting to access and print your certificate.

The training certificate will only be available for printing after completing the three required training modules and passing the test which completes the Youth Protection Training. It is available on my.Scouting on the Dashboard by clicking the print icon:



After clicking the print icon, the certificate opens as a pdf that can be printed and/or saved:



### Old YPT DVDs

All councils are instructed to destroy old Youth Protection Training DVDs, including old adult Youth Protection Training and Venturing Youth Protection Training, as they will no longer be valid.
