

Pack and Troop Self-Assessment

Topics for Review by Pack/Troop Committee

Training

- Monitor the expiration date of Youth Protection Training for all registered adults. Notify those adults whose training will expire before the end of the current year, and verify successful completion of the training.
- Verify that all registered adults have completed the basic training requirements for their respective leadership position. For those adults who will be changing their leadership position, provide information about any additional training that will be required.

Membership

- Have an active plan for year-round recruiting of youth and adult members, and for retaining them in the program.
- Engage all of the unit's families in some form of supporting leadership role.

Finance

- Have a budget that is continually reviewed by the committee and follows the BSA policies relating to fundraising and fiscal management.

Program

- Conduct an annual program planning meeting, and communicate the plan to all of the unit's families.
- Schedule monthly activities, including outdoor activities. All activities should have advancement and leadership-development opportunities for the youth members.
- Schedule periodic community-service projects.
- Have a consistent schedule of den and pack, or patrol and troop, meetings.
- Have monthly committee meetings, and include on the agenda the achievement status of the unit's Journey to Excellence goals.
