Scout, Venturing, and Explorer Participant Qualifications:

- MUST have a current BSA membership with a Scouts BSA Troop, a Venturing Crew, or Explorer Post.
- Must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree but have not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
- Be approved by the unit leader and the local council (i.e., Monmouth Council.)
- Participate in pre-jamboree training experience with Monmouth Council.
- Filed a BSA Health & Medical Record with their council within one year of attending the Jamboree. (The local council will provide specifics closer to the Jamboree.).
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.

Young Adult Participant Qualifications:

- MUST have a current BSA membership along with a current YPT certificate.
- Must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree, but have not reached their 21th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
- Be approved by the Monmouth Council
- Participate in pre-jamboree training experience with Monmouth Council.
- Filed a BSA Health & Medical Record with their council within one year of attending the Jamboree. (The local council will provide specifics closer to the Jamboree.).
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.

We (*youth participant and parent/guardian*) or **I** (*young adult participant*) have read, understand, and agree to the Mandatory Terms for Participants, including the Code of Conduct and Terms and Conditions Waiver.

Payment Schedule is as follows:

Registration Fee -- \$175 due with this application

First Payment -- \$600 also due with this application

Second Payment -- \$750 due October 31, 2022

Third and Final Payment --\$725 due January 31, 2023

We (I) understand that we must make all payments on time and according to the payment schedule above. We (I) understand late payments will carry a \$20 late payment charge. If payments are not made according to the schedule, we (I) understand the participant may be dropped from the active roster and moved to the wait list until payments are made current. Once payments are current, the participant will be reassigned to the first available slot.

Refund Policy: Prior to April 30, 2023 -- If the participant should decide to drop from the Council contingent a paid replacement must be found before any refunds can be granted. If a paid replacement is found, you will be granted a refund for **payments made minus a \$175 administration fee**. After April 30, 2023 --- If participant drops out after this date, they will be considered a "late dropout". Refunds for late dropouts will not be considered until after the Jamboree. This policy is necessary to ensure we have payment for a full contingent.

We (I) understand that while submission of this form and payment of the required fee will temporarily reserve a slot in the Council contingent, **registration is not complete until the National on-line registration process found at <http://www.summitbsa.org/events/jamboree/jamboree-registration/> is completed.**
