

Our FSR Summer Camp Staff Wants to Pull You In



Volunteer Commissioners at FSR serve in a support role for the summer camp staff. Sometimes that support includes counseling and instruction, but mostly we serve as a liaison between the campers and the senior leadership of the summer camp staff, principally by getting feedback on the quality of the camp program and providing support for problem resolution. We also help with many other camp activities, such as providing assistance with camp maintenance chores, equipment repairs, trash disposal, etc.

A volunteer Commissioner needs to be currently registered with the BSA, but not necessarily as a Commissioner. The most important qualifications are a familiarity with (and indeed a passion for) camping at FSR, and a commitment to work with the summer camp staff to provide customer support for the campers. Volunteer Commissioners typically serve for one week during summer camp.

We need to recruit more volunteer Commissioners to serve at FSR summer camp. We need to expand our target audience because the group of our long-time veterans is thinning out, and most younger, former FSR staffers have family and job issues that make it difficult for them to afford the time to do this. In particular, there are several troops with active adult leaders who no longer have a boy in the program. Perhaps you, or someone you know, would be a good candidate.
