## What is NYLT?

NYLT is a rigorous youth leadership training program that provides skills for life and is designed to benefit and enhance the leadership teams of troops and crews. It is fun, challenging, and informative. The NYLT course centers on the concepts of what a leader must BE, what a leader must KNOW, and what a leader must DO. The key elements are taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the participants go on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership. NYLT is a seven-day course. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun, guiding environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids which allow participants to understand and employ the "Tool Box" of leadership skills much more quickly.

## Who may attend NYLT?

A registered Scouts BSA:

- 13 years of age but not older than 18 years of age.
- Scouts must have obtained First Class rank and completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops at their home unit.
- Highly recommended to have 1 year of outdoor and summer camping experience.

or

Program eligible youth Venturers and Sea Scouts:

- 14 years of age but no older than 21 years of age.
- Completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships at their home unit.
- Highly recommended to have 1 year of outdoor camping experience
